“Margaret Bopp established herself as one of our country’s top High Amateur riders on her bay gelding *Nerval de la Batia*. Matti Fisher and her *As You Wish* are winning in the Amateur Owner Hunters—Indoors 2012! Emma Postal moved up and excelled in the High Amateurs by season’s end with her mount *Triumph*. Halle Fogel with her mount *Limited Edition* is successfully jumping at the 1.30m level. Brittain Ezzes is now a Low A/O rider with her mount *Empire* and is targeting moving up in 2012. Ashley McLlwain went from never riding

jumpers before 2011 to a solid 1.30m WOW! Kate Bundy is now winning in equitation with her mount *Luciano* a Medal, Maclay, and USEF Finals are in the crosshairs for next fall. Isabell and her mount *Rico Suave* are the perfect combination to beat going into this year’s Equestrian Festival.”

Grand Prix rider Peter Leone owns and operates Lionshare Farm in Greenwich, Connecticut and teaches riders of all levels. Highlights of his career include being named Best Child Rider at the Washington International, Pennsylvania National Horse Show; winning the International Derby in Newport, RI at age 20; competing 1st when they finished 4th in the World Championship Dublin, Ireland in 1984 and also in 1992 when he won the Silver Medal at the Olympic Games.
